The descriptions below list the criteria on which this grade was based, select 2 ticks for each of the 6 categories.

- A**      Excellent answer to the question  
          [bonus] Answer beyond what was expected. Expresses ideas unknown to the grader  
 Had depth of insight related to these perspectives  
 Provided a range of evidence types, data, and results to support the answer
- Very well structured piece of work  
 Writing and figures were very clear, easy to read, and adequately synthetic  
 Work was well supported by citations, referenced on a professional level  
 Team and writing were seamless across sections
- B**      Addresses the question clearly and competently  
 Has good insight and understanding related to these perspectives  
 Provided appropriate evidence, data and results to meet the requirement.
- Well-organized answer  
 Writing and figures were clear  
 Work was clearly if not completely supported by citations.  
 Team and sections were noticeably but not awkwardly different, some suggestions for differential grading
- C**      Addresses the question only adequately  
 Has concepts basically correct with respect to these perspectives.  
 Insufficient selectivity of evidence, data and results to meet the requirement.
- Essay was modestly well organized  
 Writing has some inconsistency.  
 Work was poorly supported by citations  
 Sections varied and suggestions for differential grading
- D**      Doesn't come to grips with the question  
 Misunderstands basic concepts with respect to these perspectives.  
 Lack of evidence, data or results to support the answer
- Essay was poorly structured  
 Writing was hard to read  
 Insufficient citations or not at all  
 Sections varied in quality and length, strong evidence for differential grading
- F**     Some points, but not a pass, no real merit
